Health & Vaccination

Your puppy should visit a veterinarian within the first week after bringing him home to discuss your puppy's health needs. Annual check-ups after the first year also help ensure a long, healthy life for your new pet. Your pet provider will also supply important healthcare information.

Taking Your New Puppy Home

Taking your new puppy home is very similar to that of a newborn baby. Your puppy will need time to adjust to its new surroundings and environment. During this time, it's important for you to help make this adjustment as stress free as possible. It is also important to supervise your new pet's interaction with existing pets in the house to avoid injury and ensure all animals are eating properly.

Bathing & Grooming

Use only quality shampoos specifically designed for dogs and puppies when washing your new pet. Flea and tick shampoos may be used for dogs that spend time outdoors, and oatmeal or tea tree shampoos can be beneficial for dogs with itchy or flaky skin. It's important that you not bathe your puppy too often as it can be harmful to their coat and skin. For comfort, avoid letting your puppy get cold during and after their bath.
